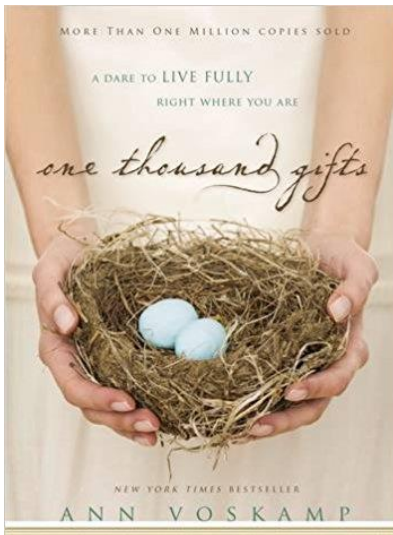


Pastor's Book Club – October/November Pick
